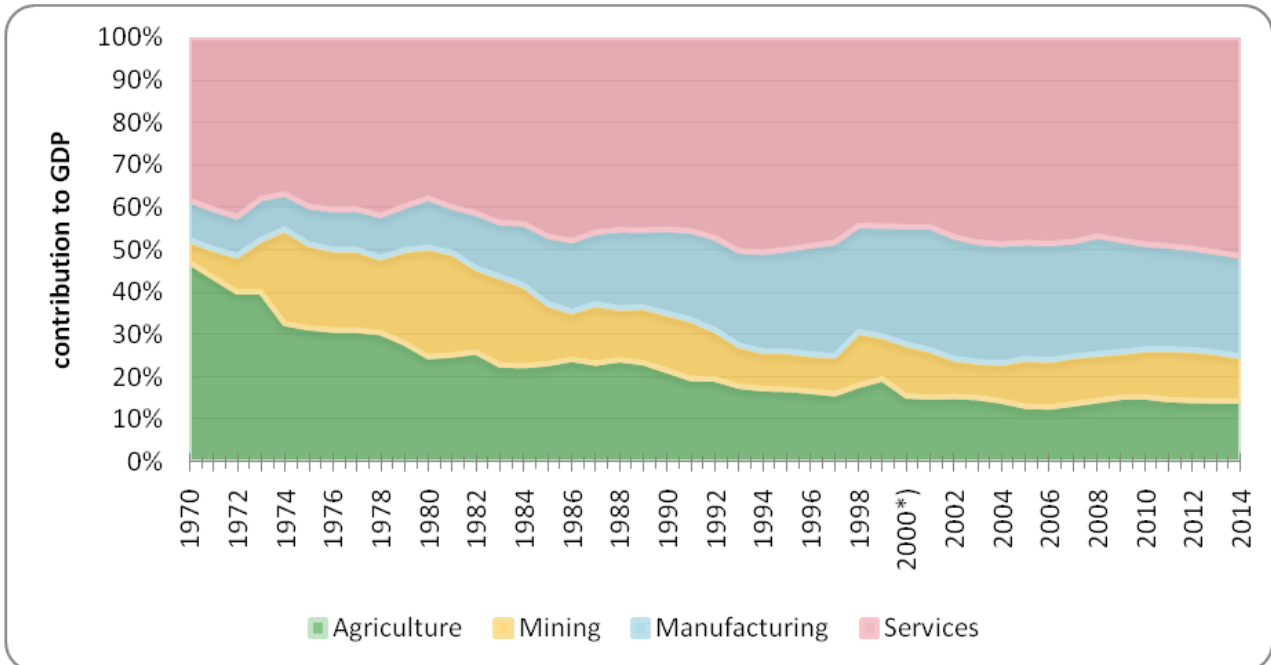




## Services sectors contribute to the economy

Parallel to structural transformation from agricultural-based economy to manufacturing and to services-based economy, services sectors' contribution to GDP has increased from 38% in 1970 to 51% in 2014.

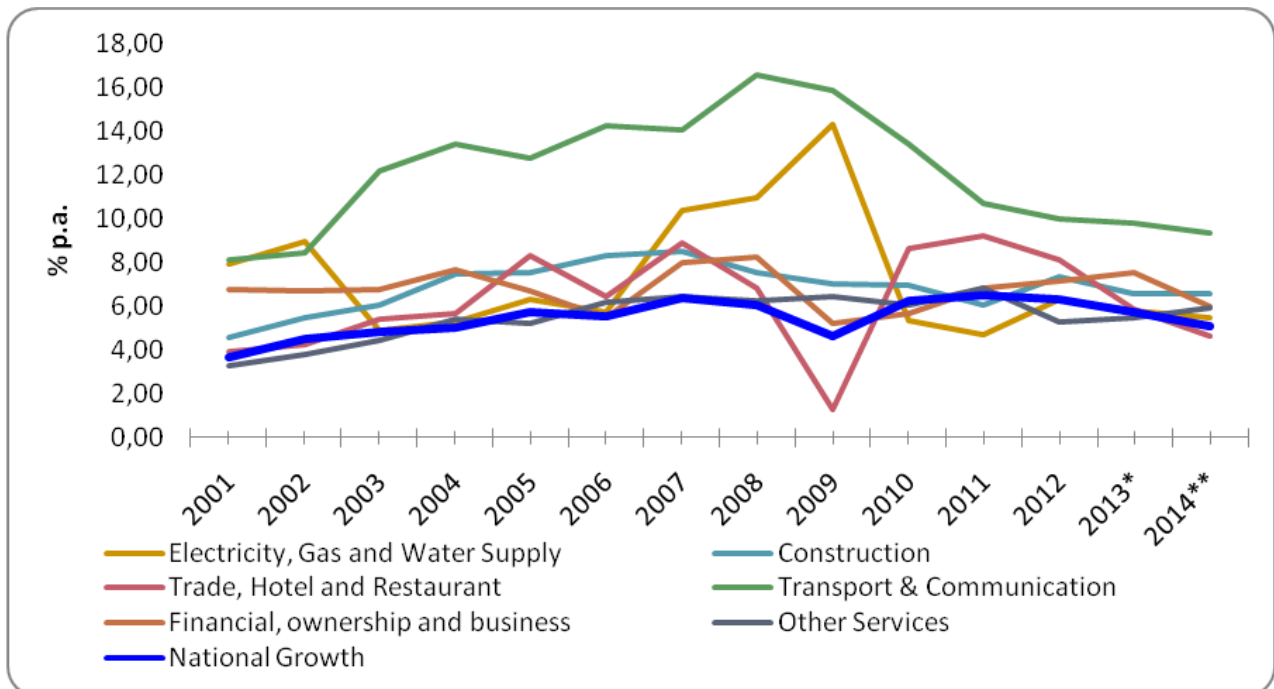

## Services sectors contribute to the economy

Most subsectors of services have maintained higher growth level than the national average growth over the past 15 years. Some of them, including utilities, transport and communication sectors, were able to maintain double-digit growth in the middle of global financial crisis in 2009.

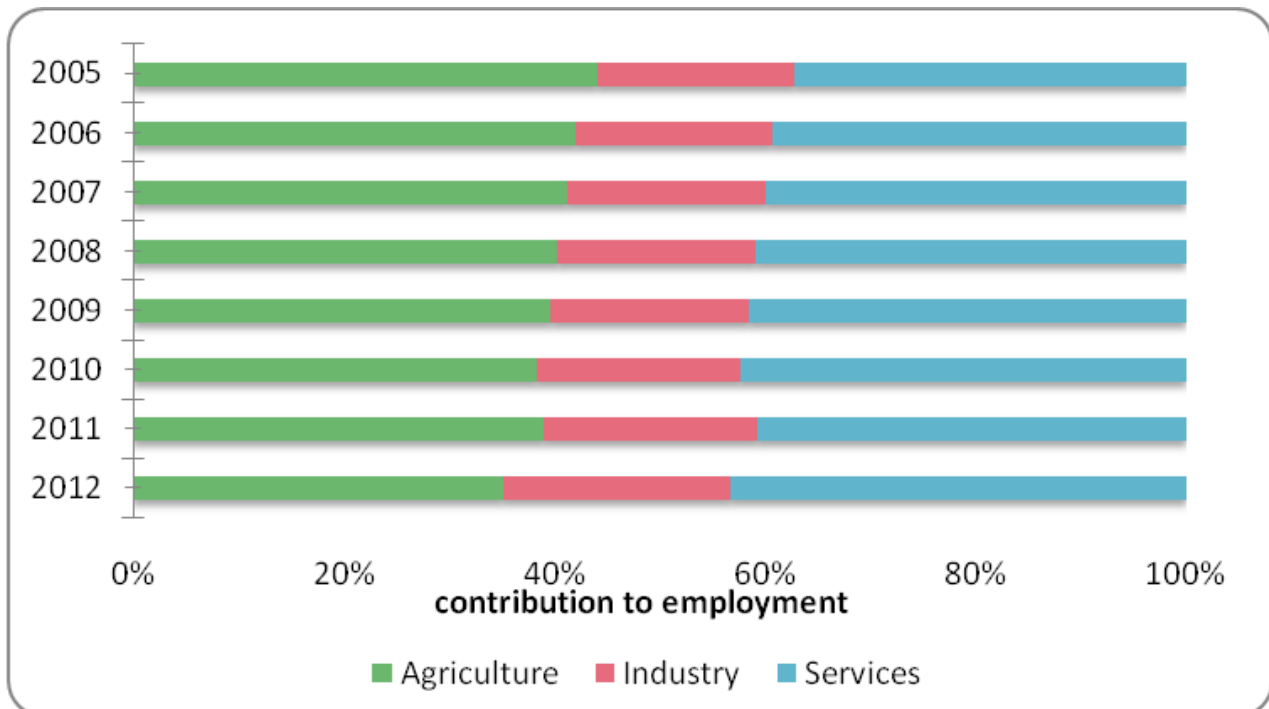
